Siem Reap is a city in northwestern Cambodia, most famous as the gateway to the Angkor Archaeological Park, which includes the legendary Angkor Wat temple complex — the largest religious monument in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

DAY 1

SIEM REAP ARRIVAL - NIGHT MARKET - PUB STREET APSARA SHOW (X/X/D)



Arrive Siem Reap Angkor International Airport, welcome and transfer to city (50 kms / 1 hour drive). Hotel check in (Standard check in time : 1400, complimentary early check in is up on hotel 's availability). Visit **Wat Preh Prom Roth** – the most beautiful functional Buddhism temple lying along the River of Siem Reap. Follow by taking a short walk along the road in front of the King's Residence to see the Main Shrine, where the local people usually worship, with its **statue of Yeay Teap, Preah Ang Chek and Preah Ang Chorm**. Buying jasmine and lotus flowers to worship is very important for the Cambodians. Evening, enjoy The **Apsara Dance show** with other four / five performances by



Cambodian young generation in a local restaurant where your buffer/set dinner to be served. After the performance, visit a famous pub street, local night market. Go back to your hotel and enjoy your stay. ***Airport transfer without guide.***

DAY 2 FULL DAY EXPLORE ANGKOR WAT, ANGKOR THOM CITY, TAPROHM TEMPLE (B/L/D)



Begin your stunning day with having a delicious breakfast at the hotel. Then with your professional tour guide, go discover the world's Greatest Monument - **Angkor Wat**. Unlike other temples in Cambodia face to the East, Angkor Wat faces to the West. **Angkor Wat**, the largest temple in the world with a volume of stones equalizing that of the Cheops Pyramid in Egypt. Next, explore the **Great Angkor City of Khmer Empire** which is the highest period of kingdom. Start at South gate of Angkor Thom, where you can collect the nice beautiful of Tonle Om River surrounding the whole city. Visit **Bayon Temple**, the state Buddhism temple built in the late 12th or early 13th century by Great King Jayaraman VII. In the palace enclosure, visit another main temple of **Bapoun**, the 11th century mountain temple built as the state temple of Suryavarman I dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva. Continue to **The Terrace le Elephants**, which was used by Angkor's king Jayavarman VII as a platform from which to view his victorious returning army.

The Terrace of the Leper King is located in the

northwest corner of the Royal Square of Angkor Thom, Cambodia. Continue to visit another hidden jungle temple of **Taprohm**. Taprohm is the modern name of Rajavihara, built in Bayon style in late 12th

century. Dinner & Overnight in Siem Reap.

DAY 3

EXCURSION TO KULEN MOUNTAIN - FLOATING VILLAGE (B/L/D)



Today, drive 58kms from Siem Reap town to the north of province to visit the Sacred hilltop. **Mahendraparvata** is considered a holy mountain in Cambodia, of special religious significance to Hindus and Buddhists who come to the mountain in pilgrimage. It also has a major symbolic importance for Cambodians as the birthplace of the **ancient Khmer Empire**, for it was at Phnom Kulen that King Jayavarma II proclaimed independence from Java in 804 CE. The Kulen National Park contains many sites of natural and historical interest. A magnificent waterfall dominates the forest terrain and draws countless local visitors on weekends and national holidays. Visit **The River of a Thousands Lingas - The cult of worshipping carved in the riverbed which represent to Hindu God of Shiva**. Walk via along flight of steps to visit **Biggest Reclining Buddha Statue housed on a massive boulder which is believed as The Holiest in the Country**. A viewing platform at the top affords sweeping views of the surrounding jungle and hillsides. Then **Enjoy and then**

take the nice photos of Nicest Waterfall in Cambodia. Late Afternoon, come down the mountain, and have local lunch at the Khmer Local restaurant at the mountain range. Drive to Chong Kneas which is 13kms from city center to visit **Tonle Sap**, the largest freshwater lake in South East Asia. Get in **Private boat, visit floating villages of residents**, see how they live and make their living on floating

houses. Enjoy the view floating market, floating school, pagoda, health centre, crocodile farm. and the residential daily life. Dinner in *local restaurant and overnight.*

DAY 4 **HOTEL - RETURN TO AIRPORT (B/X/X)**



Enjoy your breakfast and free time and enjoy your leisure for shopping at one of the city's lively open markets, Psar Chars, also called the "Old Market", where anything and everything is for sale. OR relax at hotel till time transfer to Siem Reap airport for boarding flight home. *Our Services End! Airport transfer without guide.*
